No time is a good time to ask for money. We are aware that the cost of living for families is currently very high and we do not expect you to give more than you are able to. However, we know the difference we are trying to make in the lives of those we minister to and we want to be able to continue doing this.



As Fr Peter states in his letter to parishioners, ***“we do have major financial commitments to meet such as the maintenance of our four churches and halls and the employment of four lay people”*** to assist the priests in ministry to our parishioners.

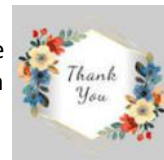
It is important for you to note that this is not a fund-raiser for the future plans for our parish.
